Distancing and Occupancy:

*All dancers will have a taped off area on the floor that is theirs to dance in. They will dance in that area. Dancers will not be partnering or touching or using handheld props. Older classes will be allowed to go across the floor while maintaining 6 feet of separation.

* The amount of dancers we are allowed in each studio is as follows:

Studio "A"- 20 occupants.....we will limit it to 14 plus instructor

Studio "B'-18 occupants.....we will limit it to 11 plus instructor

Studio "C"- -11 occupants.....we will not be using this studio in order to keep number of bodies down in the building and lobby.

*For classes bigger than 14 (Saturday Ballet) we have installed a camera into Studio "A" with live feed into Studio "A"&"C" allowing us to hold class in 3 different studios at the same time so we can keep the number of dancers in a room to our limited number.

*Masks are required for all staff and dancers. Dancers under the age of 5 are not required to wear masks.

*Dancers will be asked to use hand sanitizer before entering the studio and on their way out the door. If for some reason this is an issue for your dancer (allergies) please let us know and we will make sure they go in and use the bathroom to wash their hands instead.

Operations:

*Masks are required for all staff and dancers. Dancers under the age of 5 are not required to wear masks.

*Dancer's must bring their own water bottle to class. The water fountain has been turned off.

*Parents will have to check in all dancers at the front door and wait in the parking lot either in their car or outside the studio until it is time to gather your dancer from class (this is taken from summer camp and youth sports guidelines from the Oregon Health Authority). Dancers will be release at the front door when their class is done. The only exception to this rule is the 2:00pm 3-4 year old classes as well as the Friday 4:30pm class. Those classes may have one parent/guardian in the lobby. Zoom links will run for all classes if parents would like to watch the class from their car however, camera will be focused on Teacher and not the dancers in the class. This is because the zoom will be set up for those dancers learning on zoom from home.

*Parents and sibling are more than welcome to come into the studio and use the restroom while waiting in their car just please wear a mask.

*Signs will be posted around the studio to remind dancers of social distancing but please talk to them about wanting to hug and hang on their friends. (I know this is a hard on we are all in need of some serious hugs about now)

*We will have the studio door open on most days and air conditioning/fan running to make sure we have the best ventilation as possible.

*We will have hand sanitizer in all studios and in the lobby for dancers to use.

*Dancers will be asked to use hand sanitizer before entering the studio and on their way out the door. If for some reason this is an issue for your dancer (allergies) please let us know and we will make sure they go in and use the bathroom to wash their hands instead.

Cleaning and Disinfection;

*Floors are disinfected and clean nightly

*High touch surfaces like light switches and door handles are cleaned 3 times a day.

*Cubbies are also wiped down after use.

*Mats are disinfected after each tumbling class.

*Restroom will be cleaned once in the morning, once in the afternoon and once in the evening.

Client Screening

*Parents will have to sign dancers in stating that

Their child has not had a new or worsening cough

Had a fever

Had shortness of breath

Been in close contact with anyone with the above symptoms or anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days.

If the answer is yes to any of the above questions we will ask for you to take your dancer home.

*DO NOT BRING DANCER TO CLASS IF THEY HAVE BEEN EXPERIENCING ANY COLD SYMPTOMS OR IF THEY DO NOT FEEL GOOD. We will be offering zoom classes so if your child does not feel well have them stay home and do online class please.
